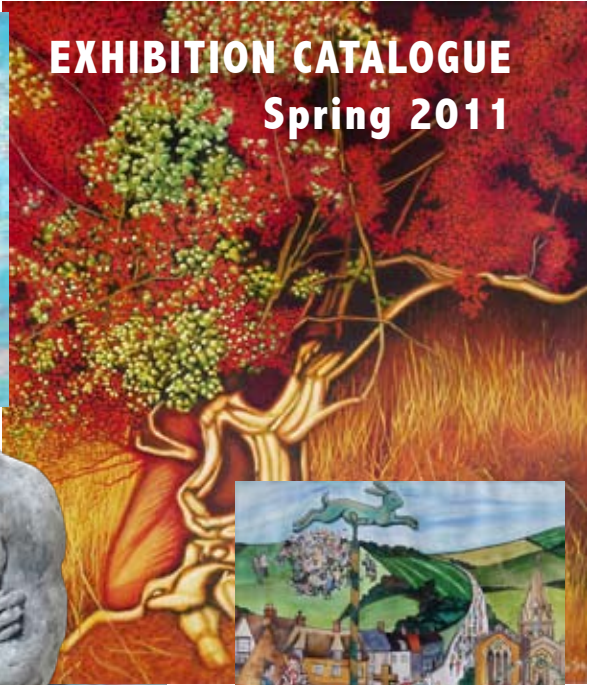

The Welland Valley Art Society was founded in Uppingham in 1945 but soon moved to Stamford. Every Autumn since 1957 it has held an exhibition in the Wilfred Wood gallery in the Arts Centre and, since 1998, it has also held one in the Spring.

Membership of the Society includes a mix of leisure and professional artists which has helped us to arrange a varied programme of activities.

Regular indoor meetings are normally held in the studio in the Arts Centre. These include weekly life and sculpture classes. A weekly portrait class is held at Tolethorpe Hall and, from Spring to Autumn, weekly outdoor meetings are held in a variety of locations within the region.
